While we hoped that Congress would approve the continuation of the biodiesel FET credit before December 31, 2011, the issue has not yet been addressed. Though the biodiesel credit is a fraction of the support and incentives received by the petroleum industry, it has allowed biodiesel producers to compete in a petroleum-dominated market. The management of Pacific Biodiesel is reviewing the situation, but without this federal assistance we will likely be forced to increase our fuel prices before the end of January 2012.

Please help us help you continue to be an agent of change. You can help keep biodiesel competitive by voicing your support for clean, renewable fuel and letting Congress know that inaction on renewable energy is inexcusable!
